 - o It was noted that local maps would be helpful for members to attain perspective as well as the properties surrounding the well head protection areas.
 - o It was also noted that if all parcels are delineated for other sectors, the same should hold true for the industrial sector.
 - o It was further noted that a clearer definition is required for "managed land".
 - o It was also further noted that local knowledge is essential for success and a process must be in place to capture this information.
 - o It was also further noted that it needs to be established if historical information is the responsibility of current owners.
