- b) Source Protection Planning Update:
  - Jennifer Boyer and Alison McDonald reviewed the staff report with the Raisin-South Nation Source Protection Committee to provide an update on the Source Protection Planning process and present the draft proposed source protection plan..
  - It was noted that the new policy wording for policies MONITORING-2, WORKS-3 and SEWG-1 (with changes) be approved for the Draft Proposed Source Water Plan
  - o It was also noted that the policies for residential Risk Management Plans (pesticides), Nutrient Management Act review (AW-5), and TSSA support (FUEL-4) be removed.
  - o It was further noted that policies shall be created for potential existing threats related to aircraft de-icing, combined sewers, large septic systems (>10000 L/day), and pesticide storage in the vulnerable areas.
  - It was also further noted that the policies SEWG-3, WORK-3 (enhanced level protection), and GENERAL-7 (education relating to fuel oil) shall stay the same.
