A new organization structure was introduced in October 2017. Source Protection is now under the Programs and Policy branch effective December 5, 2017. The MOECC is considering incorporating new considerations for climate change.

The Raisin-South Nation Source Protection Region has more pipelines bisecting its

region than most. Trans Northern Pipeline is mandated to have an appropriate spills response strategy and plan. Trans Northern Pipeline staff have attended several emergency preparedness meetings throughout the region. Their staff will continue to liaise with Source Protection Committees, MOECC liaisons and staff to ensure Source Protection considerations are included in their emergency preparedness and response plans.
